Our Connection Program

We envision partners working with us to harvest the fruit that awaits us on the mission field. Our goal is for this mission to be alive to you, as if you were right there working next to us! We not only are available to connect with your church services, we are also available to organize connecting with your Bible studies/Small groups in the ways listed below. The souls of the Cabecar Indians are the fruit that we will both be winning for Christ in the harvest together!

How will we help you or your church keep in connection with the mission?

Through Using a Go Pro Video Camera

Our ministry work will be made available with video recordings through use of a 'Go Pro'. This is a video recording device that will allow for you to see our mission come alive through video recordings. We will be video taping many of the works that we will do on the mission field. This will allow us to strap the Go Pro to our body and go wherever we need to, hands free.

Through a Wall/Station at Your Church

We ask that when a church becomes a partner with this mission, that they would make available a wall or station area where we could have a picture of our family and some mission information posted. In this area there could be personal notes to the church, information about the Cabecar Indians, our mission statement, the wins for the mission, our goals for ministries, how to connect with the mission, and how to become a partner with the mission. Our goal is to be in connection with our partners and have a true relationship with them.

Through Skype Video Meetings

While we are on the field, we ask that you would allow us to arrange a Skype video meeting with you or your church during a main service or a Bible study / Small group time.

Through Furlough

We plan to visit our supporting and partnership churches during a time of furlough. We do not want to leave our work on the field behind for too long, but we believe it is needed to help build relationships with the partners of this mission. During the services of the churches we visit during our furlough time, we can have a display table set up, and this will give us a time for fellowship with the people in the church. If Bible studies/Small groups are available for us to meet with during our visit, this would be a fantastic alternative to a main service. When we visit during our furlough and a main service is not available to us, we can arrange a video (at your preferred length) that can be shown in a main service. This video would give you updates, videos, photos, etc.

Through our Blog on the Web

Our Blog will keep us in contact with our partners. We will be on this Blog as daily as possible, speaking about life on the mission field, the wins of the mission, our goals, and our encounters with the lost souls and with the believers. This Blog is not just a portal for us to be in contact with you, it is also for you to be in contact with us! This Blog will offer a way for you to inquire about the mission work on a regular basis. We invite you to join us on this Blog, where you can leave us your questions, encouragement, counsel, insight, and stories. We will launch this blog the day of our leave to Costa Rica. We are confident that our Blog will keep you continually connected with us and the works of this mission!

Through Recorded Video

We will compile videos to present information about the mission concerning updates, needs, prayer requests, thank you's, and more. We ask that you would make these short videos available to your main church service. If this is not possible, we can arrange a video presentation with Bible study / Small group leaders and have them show the video to the church in this way. These videos can be as short or as long as requested.
