Our Statement of Faith (simplified)

- 1. We believe in the verbal inspiration and authority of the Scriptures. We believe that the Bible reveals God, the fall of man, the way of salvation, and God's plan and purpose in the ages. We believe the Bible is the inspired, inerrant, infallible word of God. (Ps. 119:160; 2 Tim. 3:16-17; 2 Pet. 1:16-21)
- 2. We believe in the Holy Trinity as one God in three Persons, God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit. (Matt. 28:19)
- 3. We believe in the deity, virgin birth, and death, burial, and bodily resurrection of Jesus Christ. (Is. 7:14; Matt. 1:18-23; Luke 1:26-35; 2 Cor. 5:21; 1 Pet. 2:22. John 1:1, 14; John 10:30; 2 Cor. 5:19)
- 4. We believe that salvation is by grace alone, through faith alone, in Christ alone. The conditions of salvation are repentance and faith. (Luke 13:3-5; John 3:16-18; Acts 20:21; Rom. 6:23; Eph. 2:8, 9) We believe that the Holy Spirit convicts sinners, regenerates, seals, secures, and indwells every believer, (John 3:6; John 16:8-9; Rom. 8:9-11; 1 Cor. 6:19-20; Eph. 4:30; Titus 3:5)
- 5. We believe that men are justified by faith alone and are accounted righteous before God only through the merit of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. (Eph. 2:8,9; Titus 3:5,6)
- 6. We believe that the rapture of the church will happen right before the seven year tribulation. We believe in the visible, personal, and premillennial return of Christ. We believe in the everlasting conscious blessedness of the saved and the everlasting conscious punishment of the lost. (John 14:1-6; 1 Thess. 4:13-18; 2 Thess. 2:8; Rev. 19; Rev. 20:4-6; Rev. 20:11-15; Rev. 21:8)
- 7. We believe that all who trust Jesus Christ for salvation are eternally secure in Him and shall never perish. (John 3:36; John 5:24; John 10:27-30; Rom. 8:35-39; Heb. 10:39; 1 Pet. 1:5)
- 8. We believe that it is the duty and privilege of every follower of Christ and every church of the Lord Jesus Christ to endeavor to make disciples of all nations... to seek constantly to win the lost to Christ by verbal witness undergirded by a Christian lifestyle, and by other methods in harmony with the gospel of Christ. (Matt. 28:18-20; Acts 1:8)

9. We stand separated from liberalism, worldliness, and all forms of apostasy. We do not compromise with unbelief in any form. We do not agree with the Charismatic movement of our day. (2 Cor. 6:17; 1 Jn. 2:15-17; Gal. 1:8-9; Rom.16:17-18; Acts 20:28-31)
