For the last couple weekends, we've had Bible studies/church services in the home of a dear Cabécar woman, who is the mother/grandmother of her clan. We've known her for about a year, and she has attended some of our other home Bible studies in the Atirro area, but this is the first time she's had us in her home! In attendance, there were around 30-40 Cabécar in each of these Bible studies. There were three small rooms in the house, and each room was full of Cabécar! We had food, fellowship, songs of worship in Spanish and Cabécar, and the preaching of God's Word. Praise the Lord for the doors that He continues to open so that more Cabécar Indians can hear the Gospel and learn about God's Word. Please pray for more souls to be saved and discipled! HELLO, MISSION PARTNERS!

GOALS REDIRECTED FOR NIMARI AND MORAVIA

During the months of February and March, it was our aim and goal to spend time ministering to each of our three Cabécar ministry areas of Moravia, Nimari, and Atirro. Our calender was marked with reminders that we were scheduled to visit new homes and revisit other homes for Bible studies in both the Nimari and Moravia location. After having experienced a handful of reschedules to these plans, we then found out why God may have chosen to keep us from carrying out these plans during these last two months. We were told by our guide that an outbreak of Tuberculosis had occurred in the Nimari location. Praise God for His provision! Before visiting a Cabécar family in this area, our guide warned us that a Cabécar man in this family had contracted TB. Though he is in remission, it would not have been entirely safe for our children to be near this sort of disease without first having received a vaccination that would protect them against it. Our children will soon have their vaccinations, and then we will continue the work within the Nimari area.

As for the Moravia location, though many reschedules caused us to spend less time in Moravia during these months, we continue to keep in contact with the families we know in this area. They know what our family is experiencing, and they know we will be going to minister to them in the near future. They continue to text us by phone, asking us when will we be visiting them again. We have assured them that it is our heart's desire to see them again soon.

We are chomping at the bit and ready to continue our work in both of these areas in the months to come. Our calendar will soon be marked again with attempts to visit these areas for either home visits (where preaching and Bible studying is done), school visits (to share Bible stories and a teaching from the Bible with children), or for an evangelistic outreach event (where food is always served and the Gospel is always shared). Please pray with us for continued receptiveness within the Cabécar families that we minister to in these locations. Also, pray for those Cabécar believers in the Moravia area who have received a discipleship program from us that they would grow and serve as a result of this Biblical guidance.

ATIRRO FOCUS

For these past two months, our attention has been directed mostly upon the work in the Atirro location. In the month of March, we had a missionary couple (that minister to the indigenous people in Panama) visit us at our home. We also had Melanie's parents visit us, who have been missionaries to Spanish speaking people for many years. They all joined us in our ministry to the Cabécar! What a great help and blessing they all were to us! They were able to preach and serve with us at the Indian homes that we visited and ministered in and at our evangelistic outreach events.

Since our last update letter, three evangelistic outreach soccer events were conducted, where food was served, soccer was played, and the Gospel was preached. These events have connected us with many Cabécar men and their families. Because of these events, we now are able to visit a home in the Atirro area every Saturday for what the family calls in the Spanish language, a 'culto' (meaning a church service). Each Saturday we serve food, share a Bible story with the children, and preach a message from the Bible. Every week, we have transported (in the back of our truck) Cabécar family members (carrying bags of their weekly supplies) to this church service. Nearly every time we reach the road near their home, it begins to rain, and it doesn't stop. This makes it a very muddy and rough terrain for us and our vehicle. With these sorts of challenges, we just put a smile on and learn to laugh it off — boots and all!







It wasn't long after we began these services, that many asked if we could worship God together in song! We now do so together. So far, two young men have shown interest in playing the guitar to worship God in both Spanish and in their own Cabécar language! One of the young men that attends this weekly home church service said to us that he reads his Bible daily and prays and seeks to follow Jesus with his life! Praise Jesus! Just recently, during one of these services, a message was preached on a passage from the book of James, which focuses in on having friendship with God by belief in the Gospel of Jesus Christ. On this rainy day, a handful made professions of faith!!! Praise the Lord for His increase!

In this home, we and 30-40 Cabécar men, women, and children, and their dogs, chickens, and even pigs, gather into a room no larger than a small bedroom. And since nearly twenty or so children attend each week, Melanie now spends time every other week focusing in specifically on the children. All of the children watch a Bible story on our IPad, and then Melanie teaches on these passages of Scripture and the lessons that the children can learn from them. This family clan has many children that attend a nearby school. By reaching these children, we believe it will give us an opportunity to visit this school with our evangelistic ministry in the near future. This could potentially connect us with more Cabécar families in the area. Of the 30-40 Cabécar family members within this family clan, none of the adults or children had a Bible of their own.

Now, each family has received a full Bible in the Spanish language, a New Testament Bible in their Cabecar language, and a Spanish children's Bible. Can you remember the first time you received your own Bible? What a day it was, right! Please continue to pray with us that many of the saved will grow in their relationship with God by reading their Bible, and for the unsaved to receive Jesus! Continue to pray for these opportunities and for more open doors for ministry within the Atirro area!

A TIME TO GROW (Needs)

- 1.) The need for meeting places (church buildings) in two of our three different ministry locations.
- 2.) The need for sheds to be built to begin our ATV ministry.
- 3.) The need for being able to transport our ATVs to begin our ATV ministry.
- 4.) The need for bridges to be built in Moravia.
- 5.) The need for tires for our ministry vehicle.

CONNECTIONS FROM GOD (Praises)

Please, join us in thanking the Lord for the awesome work He has been doing to seek the lost and equip the saved Cabécar families that we minister to here in Costa Rica!

- 1.) He has given us many new opportunities to connect with Cabécar.
- 2.) Soccer jerseys were given and issued to a Cabécar soccer team last week in Atirro, and this has connected us with new families from another nearby area!
- 3.) Another set of children's soccer jerseys were supplied to us, and we believe they will be used to reach young Cabécar children that attend a school in the Nimari area!
- 4.) God continues to supply our needs, and we are able to preach and teach the Gospel and equip Cabécar believers with the Word of God!
- 5.) We are able to be missionaries to the Cabécar and experience the hand shakes, hugs, smiles, and nods of agreement, as we share both the Bible and our lives with these precious souls!

Thank you for your continued faithfulness to God in supporting our family as we carry out this ministry to the Cabécar Indians of the Talamancan mountains! It is because of your continued prayers and giving that we are able to be a part of what Jesus is doing here and with what He plans to do in the hearts and lives of these Cabécar!



Happy New Year, to all our friends and family! We thank and praise the Lord for the wonderful year He has given us to serve Him in Costa Rica reaching the Cabécar Indians for Him! On New Year's Eve, we arrived back in Costa Rica from our trip to the USA. From the airport, we drove to our home that evening, bringing in the New

Year and <u>praising</u> the Lord for getting us back home safely! For the first couple weeks of January, we struggled with colds and coughs. But, <u>thank</u> the Lord, we recovered and got our needed rest, and we are back to doing ministry with the Cabécar Indians.

It was a great time of fellowship that we had with one of our guides and his family from the San Joaquin / Nimari area. We were able to plan and talk about ministry goals and how we would be able to work together this year in reaching more Cabécar with the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Our plans for this Nimari/Pacuare area are to visit more Cabécar families for home Bible studies, visit schools to share the Gospel with the Cabécar children, and do evangelistic events using soccer games as a tool to reach Cabécar families and young people. Praise the Lord for these opportunities!





This past month in the Atirro area, we were able to visit with several Cabécar families in their homes/living areas. The Lord has given us the opportunity to help some of these families with some basic needs such as food, clothing, shoes, and school supplies. One of the families had a birthday party, and we were invited to attend, celebrate, and help with their festivities! Another family that we visited consists of some young couples with young children, and the young men in this family clan are part of the Cabécar soccer team in this area. We thank the Lord that some soccer jerseys have been provided for us to give to this Cabécar soccer team! We will also have some soccer jerseys that we can give to another young Cabécar soccer team in a different area. We would like to

thank those who have contributed and helped with supplying these soccer jerseys. This has been a huge open door for us in reaching these young Cabécar families for Christ!

In the Chirripo area, we were able to make the long, mountainous, jungle trek up to see our beloved Cabécar friends that live in the Moravia area! It was good to see them again and be able to share God's Word with them. Quintin was able to speak and read his Bible study message to this family in Spanish, without Melanie having to interpret from English to Spanish. Quintin was also able to read a passage in the Cabécar Bible. They were able to understand the message, and we believe that the Lord used this Bible message (in Spanish and Cabécar) to touch their hearts! Praise God!
